OPENING ORDER

Black Mountain Feeders, LLC (Black Mountain Feeders) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act).¹

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, *et seq.* Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive,

or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as an Appendix. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Black Mountain Feeders for violation of the following provisions of the Act:

KRS 367.4911(6) – The Excavator shall protect and preserve temporary underground facility markers until the scheduled excavation or demolition is completed.

KRS 367.4911(10) – When excavation or demolition is necessary within the approximate location of the underground facility, the excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility.

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Black Mountain Feeders violated the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation into the excavation damage incident should be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Black Mountain Feeders shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to PSCED@ky.gov with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.
- 2. Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in

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Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.

3. The Staff Incident Report 31795 in the Appendix to this Order is made a part of the record in this case.

4. Please note that notice of a hearing to be held in this matter will be mailed to Black Mountain Feeders once proof of service is received by the Commission. Parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.

On 03/16/20 the Operator, Benton Gas System's Brittany Canup, stated that the gas main was damaged by a skid steer with an attached auger. Ms. Canup stated that no photographs were available and the locate marks were not visible due to the traffic by the skid steer. Ms. Canup stated that Black Mountain Feeders, LLC was the company installing the fence.

On 03/16/20 the Excavator, Black Mountain Feeders' Tyler Willett, stated that the gas line was damaged by a skid steer with an auger attached to erect a fence. Mr. Willett stated that the gas main was correctly marked and the location marks were worn away by skid steer traffic. Mr. Willett was receptive to attending the Damage Prevention Course and payment of the reduced penalty of \$250.00.
