<u>O R D E R</u>

On June 1, 2021, LaRue County Water District No. 1 (LaRue District No. 1) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

Having reviewed the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. LaRue District No. 1 purchases water from the city of Campbellsville (Campbellsville), Green-Taylor Water District (Green-Taylor District), the city of Bardstown (Bardstown), the city of New Haven (New Haven), Green River Valley Water District (Green River Valley District), and the city of Hodgenville (Hodgenville).

2. Bardstown notified LaRue District No. 1 that its wholesale rate would increase from \$2.49 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.56 per 1,000 gallons effective July 1, 2021. LaRue District No. 1 proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective July 1, 2021, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Bardstown.

3. LaRue District No. 1 proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons in its application.

4. During the 12 months ended April 30, 2021, LaRue District No. 1 purchased 16,254,000 gallons of water from Campbellsville, 3,597,000 gallons of water from Green-Taylor District, 35,232,300 gallons of water from Bardstown, 2,119,300 gallons of water from New Haven, 92,417,900 gallons of water from Green River Valley District, and 46,082,600 gallons of water from Hodgenville. During the same period, LaRue District No. 1 sold 167,774,538 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$2,466.24, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

6. LaRue District No. 1's proposed rates are approved.

7. The rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just and reasonable, and should be approved for water service rendered by LaRue District No. 1 on and after July 1, 2021.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons is approved.

2. The rates proposed by LaRue District No. 1 are approved.

3. The rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are approved for water service rendered by LaRue District No. 1 on and after July 1, 2021.


