### ORDER

On July 16, 2021, Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the treated sewage adjustment procedure.<sup>1</sup>

An examination of finances outlined in the annual reports<sup>2</sup> and audit reports<sup>3</sup> filed with the Commission finds that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District has been operating with a negative net income from 2015 through 2019.

Additionally, Staff found a payable expense of \$341,334 from the sewer division that corresponds to a receivable in the same amount to the water division.<sup>4</sup> This indicates that there may be subsidization of the sewer division by the water division.

The Commission notes that in the final Order of Case No. 2020-00382, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District was ordered to file for an adjustment in base rates or file for an alternative rate filing within one year of the date of the filing of the Order.<sup>5</sup> It was not specifically stated that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District should file for an adjustment in base rates for both water and sewer divisions. However, in order to avoid any confusion, the Commission clarifies that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District shall file for a simultaneous adjustment in base rates for its sewer division as well as its water division. In consideration of the short time between now and the previously expected file date of

January 29, 2021, the Commission finds that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District shall be granted an extension to file its simultaneous rate adjustment no later than March 1, 2022.

Having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District purchases sewage treatment services from Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG).
- 2. LFUCG notified Jessamine-South Elkhorn District that, effective for sewage services rendered on and after July 1, 2021, LFUCG's wholesale sewage treatment rate to Jessamine-South Elkhorn District would increase from \$6.75 per 100 cubic feet to \$7.03 per 100 cubic feet. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposes to increase the rates to its customers effective July 1, 2021, to reflect the increased cost of treated sewage.
- 3. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposes a treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District bills for sewage collection and treatment services based upon a customer's water usage.
- 5. During the 12-month period that ended May 31, 2021, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's sewer customers receiving service from LFUCG used 9,937,845.63 cubic feet of water (74,340,253 gallons of water). The increase in the cost of treated sewage is \$27,825.97, resulting in a treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons.<sup>6</sup>

- 6. The treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.
- 7. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for sewer service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after July 1, 2021.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
  - 2. The rates proposed by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District are approved.
- 3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after July 1, 2021.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
- 5. Jessamine South-Elkhorn District shall file for an adjustment in both its water and sewer division base rates or file for an alternative rate filing no later than March 1, 2022, to ensure that its rates are sufficient.
  - This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
