## ORDER

On April 27, 2022, Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) filed a motion requesting that the Commission schedule an informal conference for the purpose of discussing the logistics of the May 17, 2022 hearing. Specifically, Duke Kentucky stated that it had 25 individuals that responded to requests for information; that about half of those individuals are located in Charlotte, North Carolina; and that it would like to discuss whether each individual that sponsored a response to a data request must appear and if so, whether a virtual hearing would be possible for witnesses that only supported a small number of responses.

Having reviewed Duke Kentucky's motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that an informal conference would not be the appropriate forum to address the issues Duke Kentucky seeks to raise under the circumstances. Rather, the Commission finds that a formal conference should be scheduled for the purpose of discussing the logistics of the May 17, 2022 hearing.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Duke Kentucky's motion for an informal conference is denied.
- 2. A formal conference in this matter shall be held on Thursday, April 28, 2022, at 3 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, via video conference.
