## <u>O R D E R</u>

After reviewing the evidence of record in this proceeding, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that a formal conference on the record is necessary to address the issues raised in the application and in the intervenor's pleadings. The Commission is aware that travel to Frankfort could cause a hardship for Mr. Allen, the intervenor in this proceeding. For this reason, and because the Commission desires to have the most robust record possible upon which to base its ultimate decision in this matter, the Commission finds that Mr. Allen should notify the Executive Director by letter if he wishes to appear remotely via teleconferencing. Mr. Allen should submit this letter in the same manner in which he has submitted other documents in this proceeding. The Commission is also prepared to look favorably upon a motion to appear remotely made by Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power).

The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. A formal conference in this matter shall be held on Friday, February 11, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. Eastern Standard Time, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

Mr. Allen shall notify the Executive Director by letter no later than February
8, 2022, if he wishes to appear remotely via teleconferencing.

3. Kentucky Power shall file any motion to appear remotely no later than February 8, 2022.

4. Kentucky Power shall have Brian West, Nicholas C. Koehler, and George Reese present at the conference.

5. Counsel and Mr. Allen should be prepared to discuss the location of certain features of Mr. Allen's property, such as homes and ponds, on the parcels of land owned by Mr. Allen, and in connection with the proposed route for the transmission line, and the approximate number and location of structures that are proposed to be erected on Mr. Allen's property.

6. Each party will be given an opportunity to present its position on the pending application to the Commission
