#### ORDER

On February 8, 2022, Nicholas County Water District (Nicholas District) filed a motion requesting an additional 14 days in which to respond to Commission Staff's First Request for Information. According to the procedural schedule established by the Commission on January 18, 2022, Nicholas District was to file its response to the request for information no later than February 8, 2022.

In support of its motion, Nicholas District stated that since receiving the information request, its office employees have been out of the office for extended reasons due to inclement weather and for personal reasons.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Nicholas District has established good cause, as required by Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(1), to grant Nicholas District's motion. In addition, in consideration of the timing of the processing of this case, the Commission finds that the request for information in the current procedural schedule which would have been filed by Commission Staff on February 22, 2022, with responses due March 8, 2022, be stricken, with all other provisions of the procedural schedule to remain as scheduled.

- 2. Nicholas District shall file its response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information on or before February 22, 2022.

  - 4. All other procedural dates set forth previously will remain as scheduled.
- 5. Nothing contained in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
