ORDER

On July 1, 2022, city of Central City (Central City) filed notice of withdrawal of its application for an alternative rate adjustment for wholesale water rates that was submitted on June 28, 2022. As a basis for the notice, Central City explained that, because it is a municipality and such requests are typically processed in a tariff filing, it would file the request through the tariff system rather than in this proceeding. Central City filed the tariff in the Commission's tariff system on June 30, 2022.

Based upon a review of the notice, the Commission finds that this case should be dismissed and removed from the Commission's docket. As Central City noted, requests for wholesale rate increases filed by a municipality that, as is the case here, sells water to a jurisdictional utility are typically processed through the tariff filing system. Upon the occurrence of certain circumstances, Commission may on its own motion, open an investigation into the reasonableness of a wholesale rate increase. However, none of such circumstances are present in this proceeding, and thus the Commission concludes that this case is more appropriately processed through the Commission's tariff system.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
