COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO BEECH GROVE WATER SYSTEM, INC.

Beech Grove Water System, Inc. (Beech Grove Water), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on September 27, 2023. The Commission directs Beech Grove Water to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Beech Grove Water shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Beech Grove Water obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Beech Grove Water fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Beech Grove Water shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Beech Grove Water shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Beech Grove Water's response to Commission Staff's Second Request for Information. Provide the location of the large leak discovered by the operator, a description of the damage to the pipe that resulted in the leak, and the steps taken to repair the leak.

2. Refer to Beech Grove Water's Infrastructure Improvement Plan Proposal (Proposal) which was filed on April 14, 2023.

- a. Provide any contract, service agreement, or work proposal between Reveal Underground Services and Beech Grove Water;
 - b. Provide the cost to hire Reveal Underground Services;
 - c. Explain specifically what services Reveal Underground Services will provide and for how long;
 - d. State the estimated amount of time it will take Reveal Underground Services and Beech Grove Water to perform “leak detection for approximately 590 meters” as mentioned in the Proposal.
3. Refer to the Proposal. Provide documentation and support for the \$19,995 cost of the proposed purchase of the LEICA DS2000 radar, and a detailed description of what equipment and appurtenances are included.
4. Refer to the Proposal. Provide a detailed description of the “United Systems meter-leak system” Beach Grove Water proposed to purchase for \$30,100, including support and documentation of the purchase price, and a breakdown of the system components.
5. State who will install the “meter-leak system,” how long installation is expected to take, and how much it will cost.
6. Provide documentation and support for the assertion that the meter-leak system is compatible with Beech Grove Water’s existing meter infrastructure and billing software system.
