ORDER

This matter arises from Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative, Inc.'s (Fleming-Mason Energy) application for a general adjustment of rates, tendered on August 4, 2023, and deficiencies previously cited by in the Commission's September 19, 2023 Order.

LEGAL STANDARD

Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16(4)(e), requires an applicant to provide the average bill for each customer classification to which the proposed rate change will apply.

Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16(4)(g), requires an applicant filing a general rate adjustment to provide a detailed analysis of customers' bills whereby revenues from the present and proposed rates can be readily determined for each customer class.

BACKGROUND

On August 4, 2023, Fleming-Mason Energy tendered an application for a general adjustment of rates. On August 11, 2023, the Commission issued a deficiency letter noting multiple deficiencies. On August 17, 2023, Fleming-Mason Energy filed a response to the deficiency letter. A second deficiency letter was issued on August 21,

2023, which addressed two deficiencies still not cured. Fleming-Mason Energy filed a response to the second deficiency letter on August 28, 2023. In its response, Fleming-Mason Energy requested that the Commission find that the deficiencies were cured and that it met the minimum filing requirements. Fleming-Mason Energy also requested that, if the deficiencies were not cured, the Commission grant it a deviation or grant an informal conference (IC). On September 19, 2023, an order was issued finding that Fleming-Mason Energy was deficient regarding 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 16(4)(e) and (g), but granted it an IC. An IC was held on September 20, 2023, to discuss the deficiencies. During the IC, Fleming-Mason Energy explained how it calculated the customers' bills and the average by using the full revenue, including the riders, and how it felt the deficiencies had been cured.

FINDINGS


Having reviewed the matter and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission, on its own motion, finds that Fleming-Mason Energy cured all deficiencies and its application accepted for filing as of August 28, 2023. The calculations provided in Fleming-Mason Energy's application meet the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16(4)(e) and (g).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Fleming-Mason Energy's deficiencies have been cured and its application is deemed filed on August 28, 2023.
