COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO POWELL'S VALLEY WATER DISTRICT

Powell's Valley Water District (Powell's Valley District), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on March 9, 2026. The Commission directs Powell's Valley District to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Powell's Valley District shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Powell's Valley District obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Powell's Valley District fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Powell's Valley District shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Powell's Valley District shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Powell's Valley District's Bid for New Truck, filed February 9, 2026. Confirm that, by filing a copy of the bid, Powell's Valley District intended to request to use surcharge funds to purchase the truck.

2. Confirm that the new leak detection employee has been hired.

a. If confirmed, provide the start date of the employee and whether any or all that employee's compensation or benefits have been or will be derived from the water loss surcharge account.

b. If able to confirm that the employee has been hired, explain how Powell's Valley District has accounted for the employee's salary if paid from surcharge funds and regular operating funds.

c. If unable to confirm that the employee has been hired, provide an update regarding Powell's Valley District's hiring process for this position, including an estimated start date, and confirm that Powell's Valley District plans to seek Commission approval if it intends to pay the employee from the water loss surcharge account.

3. Refer to Powell's Valley District's Qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan (QIIP) filed March 31, 2025, at unnumbered page 6. Provide an update on the Year 1 projects described as "[i]nstall one inch bypass meters" and "install isolation valves."
