

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY

ORDER

On the Commission's own motion it is ordered that all municipal corporations of this State operating any public utility or utilities over which the Commission has jurisdiction shall be liable only for a minimum fee of \$25.00, under Section 39:2-52 and Section 3052-54 of said state's Supplement to Carroll's Kentucky Statutes. It is, therefore, ordered that those corporations her after named who have paid to the Commission more than \$25.00 for the fiscal year of 1934-35 shall be entitled to a refund of any sum over that amount which has been previously paid. The municipal corporations entitled to this refund and the amount of same are:
