In the matter of amendment of Rules 23, 25 and 27 of the Rules and Regulations for the Government of the Construction and Filing of Tariffs.

ADMINISTRATIVE  
ORDER NO. 6

On the Commission's own motion and after due consideration it is ordered that the following rules be amended so as to read as follows:

RULE 23, Sub-section (2)

If the proposed change will result in an increase of rates or charges to any customer, typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or regulations shall be mailed by the utility to each customer to be so affected, at least, twenty (20) days prior to the filing of the proposed rules or regulations with the Commission, provided, however, that when more than twenty (20) patrons will be so affected by the proposed change, it will be sufficient within the meaning of this Rule if such notice is published once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks prior to the date of filing such proposed rates or regulations with the Commission in some newspaper of general circulation in the community in which a majority of the customers reside, provided further, that the Commission upon request of the utility, may modify the requirements as to notice other than by posting in any case in which it appears proper so to do.

RULE 25, paragraph 1

Notice to the Commission of a change of rates and charges or rules and regulations, under Section 3952-16, Kentucky Statutes, shall be given by the utility by delivering to the Commission at the Secretary's office, free from all claims for postage or expressage, two (2) complete copies of the tariff or revision stating all the rates and rules it proposes to use, at least twenty (20) days prior to the effective date thereof, accompanied by a certificate in writing that notice has been given to the public in all respects as required by Rule 23 hereof. (See form of certificate of notice to the public, pages 16 and 17.)

Further, amend Rule 25 by taking therefrom the last sentence, which reads as follows:

No consideration will be given to telephone or telegraphic notices in computing the twenty (20) days' notice required.

RULE 27

All information and notice required by these rules shall be furnished to the Commission at the time of the filing of any proposed revisions in rates or regulations, and the twenty (20) days' statutory notice to the Commission will not commence to run and will not be computed until such information and notice is filed. The notice required under these rules will be computed in the manner proscribed by Section 453 of Carroll's Kentucky Statutes.
