ORDER


On the Commission's own motion and it appearing that the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, composed of Wilbur K. Miller, Chairman; Lloyd B. Clark and William D. Cochran, Commissioners, caused to be entered various orders from and including September 10, 1935, to and including September 28, 1935, and that said orders were caused to be entered on the Order Book of the Commission but were not signed by the Commissioners, or any of them; and it further appearing that the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, composed of Lloyd B. Clark, Chairman; William D. Cochran and Francis M. Burke, Commissioners, caused to be entered various orders from and including October 2, 1935, to and including December 18, 1935, and that said orders were caused to be entered on the Order Book but were not signed by the Commissioners, or any of them; and it appearing that the records of the Public Service Commission are incomplete to this extent, and it appearing that the orders, until signed, will have no force and effect as orders of the Commission; therefore, for the purpose of completing the records of the Commission and without adopting the orders referred to as the rulings of the personnel of this Commission but only for the purpose causing the orders as entered by the personnel of the Commission as set out above to be legal acts of


the Commission as composed at the time such orders were made, and on advice of the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky,

IT IS ORDERED, That the affidavit filed on February 8, 1936, of Louis Cox, Secretary of the Public Service Commission from and including September 10, 1935, to and including December 18, 1935, be filed and copied in full on the Order Book; and it is specifically referred to for the purpose of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the orders, rulings, and decisions of the Commission from and including September 10, 1935, to and including December 18, 1935, be and they are hereby ordered to be signed nunc pro tunc by the Chairman, J. C. W. Beckham, and the Secretary, Charles J. White, except that the orders made in Case No. 127 on November 23, 1935, and December 17, 1935, be and they are not included in the orders to be so signed.


BEFORE THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY

AFFIDAVIT

Louis Cox, being duly sworn, states that he was the duly appointed Secretary of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky from and including September 10, 1935, to and including December 18, 1935, that the Public Service Commission composed of Wilbur K. Miller, Chairman, Lloyd B. Clark and William D. Cochran, Commissioners, from and including September 10, 1935, to and including September 28, 1935; and composed of Lloyd B. Clark, Chairman, William D. Cochran and Francis M.
