O R D E R

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission of Kentucky has to its credit with the Kentucky State Treasurer a sum totaling more than \$150,000; and,

WHEREAS, it is estimated by the Commission that it will not need to carry on its work during the fiscal year from July 1, 1944, to June 30, 1945, more than \$75,000 of the sum belonging to it in the hands of the State Treasurer; and,

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Commission, it is necessary to carry a balance to be used in future years, and especially for the post-war work of the Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to put \$75,000 of its funds in such war or victory bonds as may be redeemed upon call; now,

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the Treasurer of Kentucky and the Department of Finance be and

are hereby directed to invest on behalf of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky the sum of \$75,000 in war or victory bonds that may be redeemed upon call.

Done at Frankfort, Kentucky, this June 28, 1944.
