Beardon, on behalf of this Commission, together with such other personnel as the Commission may from time to time assign, shall proceed to go upon the premises of said corporation at its office in Bowling Green, Kentucky, and such other places as may be necessary, and examine the books, records, and facilities of said corporation for the purpose of making audit of its affairs and obtaining such information and data as may appear proper in order to inform this Commission of the financial condition of said corporation.

The manager, officers and employees of said corporation are hereby directed to make available to said representatives and employees of the Commission such information as may be required for said investigation.
