ORDER

The utility companies operating in the state of Kentucky and subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky having reported to the Commission their Gross Receipts derived from intra-state business in Kentucky for the calendar year ended December 31, 1947, and the Commission having determined that its maintenance expense during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949 will be approximately \$100,000, the Commission does hereby apportion among and assess the amount of said expenses upon said utility companies in proportion to their gross earnings or receipts derived from intra-state business in Kentucky for the calendar year ended December 31, 1947, except that the assessment upon any utility is not less than \$25 as provided by KRS 278.130. The assessment upon the respective utilities is as follows:
