It appears to the Commission that the existing salary schedules effective July 1, 1957, make no provision for salary increments with respect to the office of Secretary to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the compensation of Joseph H. Taylor, Secretary to the Commission, be and the same is hereby increased from \$8,500 per annum to \$9,000 per annum, such salary to be effective as of January 1, 1959.

Done at Frankfort, Kentucky, this 3rd day of December, 1958.


