O R D E R


On April 24, 1957, Joseph H. Taylor was appointed by the Commission as Secretary to the Commission, effective as of that date, and at a salary of \$8,000 per annum.

It appears to the Commission that the existing salary schedules effective July 1, 1957, make no provision for salary increments with respect to the office of Secretary to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the compensation of Joseph H. Taylor be and the same is hereby fixed at \$8,500 per annum, such salary to be effective as of March 1, 1958.


