The Staff of the Public Service Commission has proposed that the Commission adopt the following rule:

PSC:Gen-1-VI Meter Readings and Information.

1. Information on Bills

Each bill rendered periodically by water, gas and electric utilities shall show the class of service, the present and last preceding meter readings, the date of the present reading, the number of units consumed, the meter constant, if any, the net amount for service rendered, all taxes, the adjustments, if any, and the gross amount of the bill. The date after which a penalty may apply to the gross amount must be indicated. The rate schedule under which the bill is computed shall be printed on the bill with all data necessary for the customer to check the computation of the bill unless the utility furnishes each customer a complete copy of the applicable rate schedule with all other data necessary for the customer to check the computation of the bill rendered at least once each calendar year or upon changes. Estimated or calculated bills shall be distinctly marked as such.

The Commission having considered the proposed rule and being advised hereby ORDERS that this matter be and it hereby is scheduled for public hearing at the offices of the Commission on the 21st day of July at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time.
