
BellSouth has a couple of changes to note with respect to the minutes of the informal conference. With respect to paragraph 5 of the memorandum, BellSouth would like to clarify that it expressed its determination that for those matters to be addressed by commercial agreement, BellSouth does not intend to bring them before the Commission. During the informal conference, Covad stated its view of BellSouth's position was that the Coserv Limited Liability Corporation v. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (350 F.3d 482 (5<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2003)) is relevant to this point.

BellSouth also notes that in the fourth paragraph, fourth line, May 14 should be April 14.

BellSouth appreciates the opportunity to submit comments regarding this Informal Conference Memorandum.


