**NOTICE OF FILING
APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT
A MERCHANT ELECTRIC GENERATING PLANT**

Illinois Municipal Electric Agency and Indiana Municipal Power Agency

No sooner than thirty days from the date of this notice, the Illinois Municipal Electric Agency (IMEA) and the Indiana Municipal Power Agency (IMPA) will submit an application with the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting for a Certificate to Construct a Merchant Electric Generating Plant.

The proposed project consists of a 750 MW boiler and associated steam generator, which will be constructed by the Louisville Gas and Electric Company and the Kentucky Utilities Company. IMEA and IMPA collectively own 25% of the existing Trimble County Unit 1. Pursuant to their respective Trimble County Unit 1 Participation Agreements, they also have rights to participate in the development and ownership of the new project. While their portion of this project qualifies as a merchant electricity generating facility under KRS 278.700, IMEA and IMPA are joint action agencies and will use their portion of this project to provide wholesale power to their respective member communities pursuant to long-term contracts.

The proposed plant will be constructed on the site of the existing LG Trimble County plant on Highway 1838 between Conners Ridge Rd. and Highway 754 near Bedford, KY. The project is currently designed to include selective catalytic reduction, bag house, wet lime-stone scrubber, and a wet electrostatic precipitator for air quality control. The maximum height of the proposed project structures will be approximately 285 feet, less than the existing height of the structures on the site.

Construction of this plant is subject to approval by the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting. Any person may within 30 days of the filing of the application submit a written motion with the board for leave to intervene. Any party to the proceeding may within 30 days after the application has been filed request the Board to schedule an evidentiary hearing at the Board's office, 211 Sower Blvd., Frankfort, KY 40601 by written motion. A request for a local public hearing may be made by three persons who reside in Trimble County within 30 days after the filing of a completed application. **NOTIFICATION OF FERPA RIGHTS
CHILD FIND FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES
OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES**

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords students (students over 18 years of age or who are attending a postsecondary institution) certain rights with respect to the student's education records. These rights include:

- 1) The right to inspect and review the student's education records maintained by the District. Parents or eligible students should submit to the school principal, a written request that identifies the record(s) they wish to inspect. The principal will make arrangements for access and notify the parent or eligible student of the time and place the records may be inspected.
- 2) The right to request the amendment of the student's education records if the parent or eligible student believes to be inaccurate, misleading, or in violation of privacy or other rights. Parents or eligible students may ask the District to amend a record if it is inaccurate, misleading, or in violation of their privacy or other rights. The school principal, clearly identify the part of the record they want amended. If the district decides not to amend the record as requested by the parent, the District will notify the parent or eligible student of the decision and their right to a hearing regarding the request for amendment. Additional procedures regarding the hearing procedures will be provided to the parent or eligible student upon notification of the right to a hearing.
- 3) The right to consent to disclosure of personally identifiable information from the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent. One exception which permits disclosure without consent is disclosure to school officials with legitimate educational interests. A school official is a person employed by the District as an administrator, supervisor, instructor, or support staff member (including medical staff and law enforcement unit personnel); a person serving on the District's board of education or other board, committee, or authority; a person or company with whom the District has contracted to perform a service (such as an attorney, auditor, medical consultant, or therapist); or a parent or other individual with whom the District has contracted to perform a service (such as a school official in performing his or her tasks).

The Trimble County Courthouse will offer the following 2004 Delinquent Property Tax Bills for sale on April 15, 2005 at 10 a.m. Offers to purchase these bills can be submitted in writing beginning April 8, 2005 and must be received in this office by April 14, 2005. The purchaser of a Delinquent Tax Bill will be issued a certificate of delinquency, which represents a lien upon the real estate described on the face of the tax bill. Interest at the rate of 12% per annum accrues on this certificate from the date of issuance. A \$3.00 Advertising fee will be added to the published bill.

Important Note: Payments made after the Sheriff's delinquent tax claim sale are subject to a 20% County Attorney's fee and 10% County Clerk's fee.

Taxes are sent to the name and address of the person or persons who own the property as of January 1, 2004. Some property may have been sold during the year and the new or current owners have failed to pay the taxes resulting in the previous owners names being listed as delinquent.
