## MOTION OF HENDERSON MUNICIPAL POWER & LIGHT FOR FULL INTERVENTION AND REQUESTS FOR PUBLIC HEARING AND FULL EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Comes Henderson Municipal Power & Light (hereinafter referred to as "HMP&L"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (hereinafter "Siting Board"), pursuant to KRS Chapter 278 and 807 KAR 5:110 and all other applicable law, to intervene in the above styled proceeding as a full party, with all rights and privileges of a full intervenor. In support thereof, HMP&L states as follows:

- 1. That HMP&L is a municipally owned electric power company providing electricity services to citizens within Henderson County, Kentucky. HMP&L owns and maintains electricity facilities and transmission lines through the County of Henderson, Kentucky.
- 2. On July 15, 2010, Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co., d/b/a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana, Inc. ("Vectren") filed an "Application for Certificate to Construct Nonregulated Electric Transmission Line" with the Siting Board. The

Application seeks approval to site and construct a 345 kV electric transmission line.

- 3. That the proposed route for the Vectren line directly and adversely affects HMP&L substation property and transmission lines which are central to the operations of HMP&L.
- 4. That the location of the proposed Vectren line to HMP&L's existing transmission lines including, but not limited to, the existing 161 kV transmission line which runs from HMP&L's Substation 4 to a location near HMP&L's Station Two Generation Plant will be detrimental to the future operations of the lines and compromise existing system reliability.
- 5. That the proposed route of the Vectren line will adversely affect HMP&L's existing substation property, transmission lines, and ability to provide reliable electric service for its existing and future customer base.
- 6. That because of its status as a provider of electricity to citizens within Henderson County, Kentucky, and the adverse impacts which will occur to both its operations and property, HMP&L has a special and unique interest in this proceeding and moves the Siting Board to grant it status as a full party intervenor.
- 7. That HMP&L is an interested person under KRS 278.712 and has a special interest under 807 KAR 5:110 entitling it to full intervention in this proceeding.
- 8. That the special interest of HMP&L is not otherwise adequately represented by any other intervenors or the applicant.

- 9. That the line as proposed will significantly degrade scenic assets of the Commonwealth and that its construction as proposed will be in violation of applicable law.
- 10. That the Applicant does not have, nor can it obtain, the necessary rights of way to construct a line as proposed.
- 11. That the Application is incomplete including, but not limited to, the failure to properly notify all affected property owners.
- 12. That full intervention by HMP&L will assist the Siting Board in reaching its decision, and will not unduly interrupt the proceeding.
- 13. That the attorneys for HMP&L authorized to represent it in this proceeding and to take service of all documents are:

14. That the Siting Board is hereby requested to hold a public hearing in Henderson County, Kentucky to provide a forum for all interested persons to comment and advise the Siting Board on issues relating to the Application herein.

15. That the Siting Board is hereby requested to hold a full, formal, evidentiary hearing on the application herein; including an opportunity for parties to tender evidence, cross examine witnesses and exercise the rights of due process of law afforded to all interested parties.

WHEREFORE, Henderson Municipal Power & Light moves that an order be entered in this proceeding granting it full intervenor status; that the Siting Board order a public hearing be held in Henderson County, Kentucky on the Application herein; that a full evidentiary hearing be held on the Application herein; and for any and all other relief to which HMP&L may be reasonably entitled including its costs and attorneys' fees herein expended.
