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NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF  
KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC.

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On August 21, 2014, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") filed a Motion to Intervene and a Petition to Amend Procedural Schedule in this proceeding. KIUC's intent in filing both pleadings was to better understand how Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") allocated its fuel costs between native load, all requirements FERC wholesale customers, and off-system sales during the review period and to assess the reasonableness of that approach. On August 27, 2014, KU filed Responses to Kentucky Public Service Commission Staff's data requests in this proceeding, which explain KU's fuel cost allocation approach. Having reviewed the additional information provided in KU's Responses, and having confirmed that KU allocates its lowest fuel cost resources to native load customers, KIUC no longer needs to continue its involvement in this proceeding. Consequently, KIUC hereby withdraws its Motion to Intervene and Petition to Amend Procedural Schedule.
