

REQUEST

Provide examples of all forms to be used in conjunction with each proposed new tariff.

RESPONSE

The Company has not prepared any of the forms to be used in conjunction with each proposed new tariff (PPA, BSRR, BS1OR, PJM, and NERC CIP and Cyber Security). The Commission's final order in this case could materially affect any proposed form. Accordingly, the Company's intends to work with the Commission after the tariffs have been approved to develop and finalize all of the appropriate forms prior to the first month the riders would go into effect.

- a. If yes, provide the revised monthly environmental surcharge forms.
- b. If no, explain why revised monthly environmental surcharge forms have not been prepared and state when they will be available for Commission review.

RESPONSE

a-b. The Company is currently in the process of preparing the revised environmental surcharge forms and will supplement its response to this request when the forms are finalized.

The ES Calculation provided in June for the May expense month will use in-service capital costs as of March 31, 2015, in light of the need to implement procedures for updating these values on a monthly basis. The July ES calculation will reflect May capital costs. Thereafter, the information will be presented using the second previous expense month (e.g., the August calculation will reflect June 2015 costs).

The Company respectfully requests that these revised forms be approved as a part of the Commission's approval of the 2014 Environmental Compliance Plan.
