MOTION TO DEVIATE

Applicant, **KENERGY CORP.** (“Kenergy”), moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, §22 to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, §17 (2)(b)(3).


The regulation requires that public notice be made once prior to the application in a newspaper of general publication in the newspaper’s service area. For Kenergy, this requires publication in several local newspapers, many of which are published weekly. “The Providence Journal Enterprise” was scheduled to run the Kenergy public notice on Wednesday, October 28, 2015, but through inadvertence and oversight, the public notice failed to run. (See notarized statement from “The Providence Journal Enterprise.”)

“The Providence Journal Enterprise” will now run the public notice on November 4, November 11 and November 18, 2015. Kenergy moves the Commission to allow a deviation from the regulation regarding the failure of “The Providence Journal Enterprise” to run the public notice once prior to the filing of the application.
