MOTION TO WITHDRAW

In its Order issued on February 1, 2016 initiating this case, the Commission made each local exchange carrier, commercial mobile radio service provider, and eligible telecommunications carrier (“ETC”) a party to this proceeding. The Commission also gave any party that is not an ETC in Kentucky receiving both federal universal service fund (“USF”) and state support the opportunity to file a written request setting forth the reasons why withdrawal as a party is appropriate. Mitel Cloud Services, Inc. moves to withdraw from this proceeding and states such reasons for doing so below.

ETC Status

Mitel Cloud Services, Inc. is not an ETC in Kentucky and does not receive either federal USF or state support, therefore meeting the threshold for being permitted to set forth the reasons why withdrawal from this proceeding is appropriate.

Reasons Why Withdrawal as a Party is Appropriate

Mitel Cloud Services, Inc. does not receive either federal USF or state support. It therefore has no direct interest in the level of state support provided to ETCs. After reviewing the Order and considering the likely potential impact of this proceeding, Mitel Cloud Services, Inc. has determined that it is not in its interests to participate at this time.

Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, Mitel Cloud Services, Inc. respectfully requests that it be permitted to withdraw from further participation in this proceeding.
