**LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT’S STATEMENT
CONCERNING THE STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT**

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (“LFUCG”), by counsel, hereby states they will not object to, or withdraw from, the written Stipulation and Settlement agreed to by all parties in the above referenced matters, whether or not all schools, including private or charter schools, are included in the optional pilot program for schools set forth in Article IV, Paragraph 4.11 of the Stipulation and Settlement.

In addition, with respect to the Sports Field Lighting Pilot Tariff discussed at paragraph 4.7 of the stipulation and settlement filed on April 19, 2017, it is LFUCG’s position that the Sports Field Lighting Pilot Tariff does not violate KRS 278.035. KRS 278.035 prohibits preferential retail rates by a utility for services to certain public entities. The Sports Field Lighting Pilot Tariff does not provide preferential rates to any entity because the pilot program is available to any entity regardless of funding source. Accordingly, it does not violate KRS 278.035.
