- 1. My name is Renee Honden I am employed by the Company in the position of In this position, I am personally familiar with the Federal Universal Service support received by the Company and how these funds are used by the Company.
- 2. The Company was designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier by the Kentucky Public Service Commission in PSC Case No. 2002-00323 by order dated November 26, 2002.
- The Company expects to receive \$ 1,200; or in Federal Universal Service 3. high cost support during the year January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.
- 4. Such Federal Universal Service support will be used for the provision, maintenance and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, as designated by the Federal Communications Commission consistent with Section 254(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1934, as amended. These funds will be used to provide the following supported services as outlined in 47 CFR §54.10(a), which are available to any customer in the Company's service area: single-part voice grade access to the public switched network, unlimited local usage, dual-tone multi-frequency signaling or its functional equivalent, access to emergency services, including 9-1-1 service or enhanced 9-1-1 service, access to operator service, access interexchange service and access to directory assistance and toll limitation for qualifying low income customers.
- 5. The Company follows Federal Communications Commission Part 32 accounting requirements for regulated local exchange carriers to determine high cost support amounts. As a regulated utility, the Company's accounting procedures are subject to periodic National Exchange Carrier Association and Kentucky Public Service Commission reviews.
- 6. The Company does not anticipate increasing local rates nor withdrawing any services; therefore, the comparability of rates and service between the rural areas served by the Company and the urban areas of Kentucky will not be changed because of any action on the part of the Company.
