# <u>ORDER</u>

On January 11, 1999, Owen Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Owen") filed with the Commission its application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to qualify it to bid on an electric franchise in the city of Sparta, Kentucky. Under the provisions of KRS 278.020(3), no utility may apply for a franchise from any governmental agency until it has obtained a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from this Commission based on our finding that there is a need and demand for the service sought to be rendered.

The Commission determines that there is evidence of a need and demand for electric service in the above-mentioned city. Since the Commission's authority in such matters is limited by statute to finding only whether there is a need and demand for the service sought to be rendered, no finding or determination is made as to the qualifications of the bidder, the validity of any of the provisions of the franchises offered by said city, or the manner in which any franchise fee is to be treated for rate purposes. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Owen is granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity that authorizes it to bid on an electric franchise in the above-mentioned city.

2. Owen, if it becomes the successful bidder, shall file with this Commission two copies of the franchise agreement.

3. This Order shall not be construed as granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct utility facilities in said city.

## **APPLICATION**

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Owen Electric Cooperative, Inc., "Owen", respectfully submits the following application herein pursuant to KRS 278.020:

1. Owen is a non-profit corporation without any capital stock and its post office address is 510 Main Street, Owenton, Kentucky 40359.

2. Owen's Articles of Incorporation, and any amendments thereto, have been filed with this Commission in connection with prior proceedings of Owen, most recently in Case No. 5609 dated November 24, 1971.

3. Owen is in the business of distributing and furnishing electric current to approximately 41,000 member-customers in North-Central Kentucky in the counties of Owen, Grant, Pendleton, Gallatin, Scott, Boone, Kenton, Campbell and Carroll.

4. The City of Sparta, Gallatin County, Kentucky, recently notified Owen that it had annexed additional areas within its corporate city limits which are within territory certified, for provision of retail electric service to Owen by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to the provision of KRS 278.016 to 278.018, as appearing on maps of such certified territories issued by and on file with such Commission. Further, the City of Sparta notified Owen it was offering a franchise for the transmission and distribution of electricity within the corporate limits of the City of Sparta, Kentucky, pursuant to the terms of an Ordinance dated July 5, 1978, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein designated as Exhibit "A".

5. As a result of the above mentioned annexation, Owen now serves approximately 32 customers within the corporate limits of the City of Sparta. Inasmuch as part of Owen's certified territory established pursuant to KRS 278.016 et seq. is now located within the City of Sparta, there is a need and demand for the continuation of such services by Owen within the City of Sparta.

6. Owen is ready, willing and able to continue providing retail electric service within the corporate limits of the City of Sparta.

WHEREFORE, Owen Electric Cooperative, Inc., respectfully prays that the Public Service Commission enter its order authorizing Owen to bid on the franchise offered by the City of Sparta, Kentucky.
