O R D E R

On May 18, 1999, Crown Communication Inc. ("Crown"), Tritel Communications, Inc., Tritel Finance, Inc., NPCR, Inc., d/b/a Nextel Partners and GTE Wireless of South, Inc. ("Applicants") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility. The proposed facility is to be located at 6769 Frankfort Road, Versailles, Woodford County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 38° 7' 35.91" by West Longitude 84° 47' 5.86". Crown has requested authorization to construct a cell site in Woodford County, and Tritel has provided evidence that the public convenience and necessity will be served by the proposed construction.

The Applicants have provided information regarding the structure of the tower, safety measures, and antenna design criteria for the proposed facility. Based upon the application, the design of the tower and foundation conforms to applicable nationally recognized building standards, and a Licensed Professional Engineer has certified the plans. The Applicants have filed applications with the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") and the Kentucky Airport Zoning Commission ("KAZC") seeking approval for the construction and operation of the proposed facility. Both decisions are pending.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063, the Applicants have notified the local planning commission of the proposed construction. The Zoning Administrator notified the Commission by letter dated May 21, 1999 that the planning commission objected to the location proposed. The original site location met with much opposition and, after negotiation, the Applicants amended the application to change the proposed location of the tower.

The Applicants have filed evidence of the appropriate notices provided pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063. The notices solicited any comments and informed the recipients of their right to request intervention. Numerous entities intervened. However, after the Applicants filed their amendment, many of those intervenors withdrew their objections. No one requested a hearing on the location at which the tower is currently proposed.

Pursuant to KRS 278.280, the Commission is required to determine proper practices to be observed when it finds, upon complaint or on its own motion, that the facilities of any utility subject to its jurisdiction are unreasonable, unsafe, improper, or insufficient. To assist the Commission in its efforts to comply with this mandate, Crown

should notify the Commission if it does not use this antenna tower to provide service in the manner set out in its application and this Order. Upon receipt of such notice, the Commission may, on its own motion, institute proceedings to consider the proper practices, including removal of the unused antenna tower, which should be observed by Crown.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that the Applicants have demonstrated that the facility is necessary to provide adequate utility service and therefore should be granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Crown is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a wireless telecommunications facility. The proposed facility is to be located at 6769 Frankfort Road, Versailles, Woodford County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 38° 7' 35.91" by West Longitude 84° 47' 5.86".
2. The Applicants shall file a copy of the final decisions regarding their pending FAA and KAZC applications for the proposed construction within 10 days of receiving these decisions.
3. Crown shall immediately notify the Commission in writing, if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for a period of 3 months in the manner authorized by this Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The motions of the Intervenors named herein to withdraw from this proceeding are granted.

The Commission is in receipt of your letter concerning the above application for approval to construct a cell facility. The Commission will carefully analyze this application before rendering its final decision. If you wish to intervene in this matter, you must notify the Commission in writing. However, please be advised that property rights issues are not within the scope of the Commission's jurisdiction.

It may be helpful for you to know that authority, specifically that of the Public Service Commission, in this matter has been limited by federal law. For example, Section 704 of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 prohibits this Commission from regulating the placement of wireless facilities on the basis of environmental effects of radio frequency emissions to the extent the facilities comply with Federal Communications Commission regulations. Section 704 also prohibits a state or local government from prohibiting telecommunications facilities construction if such denial will have the effect of prohibiting service. In addition, this Commission is required by statute to ensure that utility service, including telecommunications service, is adequate and reliable. The Commission does, however, consider appropriate placement of necessary facilities within applicable engineering boundaries. It also pursues a policy of collocation of facilities whenever possible.

I am contacting you at the direction of the Versailles-Midway-Woodford County Planning & Zoning Commission with regard to the above referenced communication tower. The Commission wishes to object to the joint application by Crown Communications and Tritel Communications to erect a 250' communication tower on the Devine property, which is the northwest corner of the intersection of Steele Road (Ky Hwy 1685) and Versailles Road (US 60) in Woodford County.

A communication tower at this location would violate the established US 60 Corridor Preservation area defined in the 1997 Comprehensive Plan Update. This Corridor extends along US 60 from the Fayette County line to the Franklin Co. line (outside of the Urban Service Boundary of Versailles), and is 500 feet in depth, from the existing right-of-way line of US 60. The 1997 Comprehensive Plan Update (pg. 84) states the following:

The preservation of the US 60 corridor viewshed has been determined to be a critical component to maintaining the existing character of Woodford County. One of the adopted objectives under the Tourism Goal is the preservation of unique scenic areas and horse farms that serve as drawing cards for the general public. Additionally, planning workshops attended by Woodford County residents also identified the preservation of the US 60 corridor as crucial.

The Commission hopes this information regarding the preservation of this rural scenic corridor will be an important consideration by the Public Service Commission in their determination that this site is not the most suitable for a communication tower.
