

O R D E R

On May 27, 1999, Southern Mason Water District ("Southern Mason") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068. On June 7, 1999, Southern Mason submitted an amendment to its original application.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Southern Mason purchases its water from Maysville Utility Commission ("Maysville") and Western Fleming County Water District ("Western Fleming").
2. Maysville is increasing the wholesale water rate charged to Southern Mason from \$1.3520 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.4876 per 1,000 gallons purchased effective July 1, 1999. Western Fleming is not increasing its rate.
3. During the 12 months ending March 31, 1999, Southern Mason purchased a total of 13,418,000 gallons of water and sold 45,420,000 gallons.
4. The increase in the cost of purchased water will be \$7,530.14, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons of water. Based on a monthly

usage of 5,000 gallons, the average bill of a Southern Mason customer would increase \$0.85, from \$26.37 to \$27.22 or 3.2 percent.

5. The calculations and amended tariff provided by Southern Mason are correct and should be approved.

6. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after July 1, 1999.

2. The amended tariff submitted by Southern Mason is hereby approved as filed.

3. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, Southern Mason shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.



Pursuant to City of Maysville Ordinance No. 98C-5 and further pursuant to order of the Public Service Commission and 807 KAR 5, the City of Maysville, Kentucky, hereby gives notice to the Southern Mason Water District and its customers of the City's intent to increase its general water rate 10 percent. Southern Mason Water District water rates will increase from \$1.3520 per thousand gallons to \$1.4876 per thousand gallons as provided in Water Purchase Contract dated 6 February 1992.

All other service charges, penalties, and other provisions under Code of Ordinances Chapter 150 and of all other ordinances related to water, sewer, and fire protection continue in force except to the extent of conflict with the changes noticed hereby.

The rates contained in this Notice are the rates proposed by the City of Maysville, Utility Commission; however, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be changes that differ from the proposed rates contained in this Notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene; intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.

Any person who has been granted intervention by the commission may obtain copies of or examine the rate application and any other filings made by the City of Maysville, Utility Commission by contacting its main office at 216 Bridge Street, Maysville, Kentucky 41056, phone: (606) 564-3531. The rate application and any other filings may also be examined at the office of the Public Service Commission, 731 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, phone: (502) 564-3940.

The increased rates imposed hereby shall be applicable to Maysville Utility Commission water charges to Southern Mason Water District commencing with a meter reading 15 March 1999, to be reflected on billing to be issued 30 March 1999.

Amounts billed between 1 July 1998 and 1 February 1999 in excess of \$1.3520 have been credited.

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
