Pursuant to Appendix A: Commitment No. 19 of the Commission's Order, dated August 6, 2001, in the aforementioned case, the Companies hereby notify the Commission of a new debt issuance by E.ON AG ("E.ON"). On September 17, 2008, E.ON had planned, as noted in my letter to you dated September 5, to issue a bond in the amount of 20 billion yen. The underwriter of the transaction was Lehman Brothers who was unable to perform on the transaction due to its bankruptcy filing.

E.ON has arranged for a replacement transaction for the same 20 billion yen. The bond will mature on November 10, 2038 and pay interest at a rate of 3.30%. The bond is an unsecured obligation of E.ON International Finance B.V., which is guaranteed by E.ON. This debt is in lieu of the debt described in the notice of September 5, 2008, and is not in addition to the previously described loan.
