MOTION OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY AND KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY

Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively, the "Companies"), by counsel, move the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an extension of time to file their supplemental testimony through and until Wednesday, September 29, 2004. As grounds for this motion, the Companies state that they need an additional amount of time to complete the preparation of the testimony in order to consider and reflect the impacts, if any, of recent FERC orders -- particularly one issued in *Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. / Public Utilities with Grandfathered Agreements in the Midwest ISO Region*, 108 FERC ¶ 61,236 (Order, September 16, 2004), and one issued in *Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc.*, 108 FERC ¶ 61,235 (Order, September 16, 2004). In addition to the issuance of these orders, the production of the data responses by the Midwest ISO rolling fashion meant that the Companies had less time than originally provided after the last response was filed in which to complete their testimony.

The Midwest ISO has no objection to this motion and has advised that it plans to move the Commission for similar relief. The Companies have no objection to an extension of time through September 29, 2004 for the Midwest ISO to file its supplemental testimony. The Office of the Attorney General's counsel has advised that it also has no objection to this motion on the condition that the Companies will cooperate with the Office of the Attorney General if that Office needs a few additional days to submit data requests. Counsel for the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. has advised that it has no objection to the motion.

Commission Staff has advised that it has no objection to the extension of time to file the testimony by September 29, but has recommended the procedural schedule be modified to allow the submission of additional data requests to the Companies and MISO by October 13 and responses to those data requests by October 26.

LG&E and KU propose that the Companies and MISO submit additional data requests by October 6 and file their responses by October 20, and the other parties to the proceeding and Commission Staff submit additional data requests to the Companies and MISO by October 13 and the responses to those additional data requests be filed by October 26.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully request the Commission enter an order granting them an extension of time in which to file their supplemental testimony through and until September 29, 2004 and the modifying only so much of the procedural schedule established by the Commission's August 19, 2004 Order as requested herein.
