PETITION FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 § 7, Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("Midwest ISO") hereby petitions the Public Service Commission for an Order granting confidential treatment and protection from public disclosure certain information requested by the Commission or its staff at the Commission's hearing in this matter, held from February 25 to 27, 2004. Specifically, Midwest ISO seeks confidential treatment for information responsive to a data request made by Commissioner Martin Huelsmann to Midwest ISO witness and Chief Financial Officer, Michael P. Holstein, regarding officer compensation for the years 2003 and 2004. Attached to the original of this Petition is the requested compensation data, with the material for which confidential treatment is sought identified by highlighting with transparent ink; a redacted version is attached to the copies of this Petition.

In support of its request for confidential treatment, Midwest ISO states as follows:

- 1. The compensation information provided is classified as confidential by the Kentucky Open Records Act, which excludes information of this type from the application of its disclosure mandates. KRS 61.878.
- 2. This information is (a) confidentially disclosed to the Commission or required by the Commission to be disclosed to it and (b) is generally recognized as confidential or proprietary.

 KRS 61.878(1)(c).

3. Information as to the compensation paid to Midwest ISO's officers is of a personal

nature and is treated as confidential both internally within Midwest ISO and externally. Thus,

disclosure of this information would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy

of each individual officer. KRS 61.878(1)(a). Furthermore, preservation of the confidential

character of that information is needed to prevent Midwest ISO's competitors from gaining an

unfair commercial advantage by having access to internal financial data relating to the

compensation of Midwest ISO's most senior officers. KRS 61.878(1)(c).

4. Midwest ISO's compensation data for 2003 will remain confidential until it is

reported on Form 1 to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") on or before April

30, 2004. Compensation data for 2004 shall remain confidential until it is included in a similar

FERC Form 1 filing on or before April 25, 2005.

5. No public interest would be served by denying confidential treatment to this

information.

WHEREFORE, Midwest ISO requests an Order of the Commission granting confidential

treatment to the material provided.
