I REQUEST FULL INTERVENTION IN PSC CASE NO. 2003-00266, CONCERNING AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE MEMBERSHIP OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY AND KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY IN THE MIDWEST INDEPENDENT TRANSMISSION SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC.

I AM AN ELECTRIC ONLY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER OF LG&E. I HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY GRANTED FULL INTERVENTION IN THE FOLLOWING PSC LG&E CASES:

1.98-426 PBR.
2.2000-095 POWERGEN MERGER.
3.2000-080 GAS INCREASE.
4.2000-386 POLLUTION EQUIPMENT.
5.2001-104 E.ON.
6.ADMINISTRATIVE 387 KY ADEQUACY OF GENERATION & TRANSMISSION.
7.2001-323 HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE.
8.2002-00147 POLLUTION EQUIPMENT.

I FEEL THAT I HAVE A SPECIAL INTEREST IN THIS PROCEEDING WHICH IS NOT OTHERWISE ADEQUATELY REPRESENTED. I REPRESENT THE CONCERNS OF AN ELECTRIC RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER. THE ATTORNEY GENERALS' (AG) OFFICE REPRESENTS ALL CLASSES OF CUSTOMERS. I HAVE TAKEN DIFFERENT POSITIONS ON ISSUES THAN THOSE OF THE AG AND OTHER NTERVENORS. THIS CASE HAS MANY OF THE SAME ISSUES AS ADMINISTRATIVE 387.

I AM LIKELY TO PRESENT ISSUES OR DEVELOP FACTS THAT WILL ASSIST THE PSC WITHOUT COMPLICATING OR DISRUPTING THE PROCEEDINGS. IN PREVIOUS PSC CASES I HAVE PARTICIPATED IN DATA REQUESTS, PRESENTED WRITTEN AND ORAL TESTIMONY, ASKED QUESTIONS AT THE HEARINGS AND FILED BRIEFS.

I HAVE THE FOLLOWING INITIAL CONCERNS RELATED TO THE THE CONTROL OF THE ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION FACILITIES BEING TURNED OVER TO LG&E/MISO:

1.WHETHER THE LG&E/MISO OR THE STATE OF KENTUCKY SHOULD HAVE AUTHORITY OVER THE CONTROL OF THE TRANSMISSION FACILITIES.

2.WHAT AFFECT ANY CHANGE WILL HAVE ON THE RATES AND CHARGES OF ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS.

3. WHAT AFFECT THIS MAY HAVE ON DEREGULATION OF ELECTRICITY AND

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CUSTOMERS BEING ABLE TO CHOOSE THE SUPPLIER OF ELECTRICITY.

4.ANY TYPE OF CONDITIONS THE PSC SHOULD IMPOSE IF LG&E/MISO WOULD HAVE CONTROL OVER THE TRANSMISSION FACILITIES VERSUS THE PSC.

5.WHAT FEDERAL/ STATE ISSUES THIS ISSUE RAISES.

6.IS THIS IS LEGAL ? DOES IT VIOLATE KENTUCKY STATE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS ?

7.SHOULD THE PSC IMPOSE ANY SANCTIONS ON LG&E/MISO FOR ATTEMPTING TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF THE TRANSMISSION FACILITIES WITHOUT PSC APPROVAL ?
