JOINT MOTION OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, AND KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC. TO CONSOLIDATE PROCEEDINGS

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E"), Commonwealth of Kentucky, ex. rel. A.B. Chandler, III, Attorney General, by and through the Office for Rate Intervention (the "Attorney General"), and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC"), by counsel, move the Public Service Commission of Kentucky ("Commission") to consolidate *In the Matter of: An Adjustment of the Gas and Electric Rates, Terms and Conditions of Louisville Gas and Electric Company*, Case No. 2003-00433 with *In the Matter of: An Investigation Pursuant to KRS 278.260 of the Earnings Sharing Mechanism Tariff of Louisville Gas and Electric Company*, Case No. 2003-00335. The grounds supporting this motion are set forth below.

On September 4, 2003, the Commission initiated its own investigation, pursuant to KRS 278.260, of the revised tariffs filed by Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") and LG&E to continue their respective Earnings Sharing Mechanism ("ESM") tariffs for an additional 3-year

term ending December 31, 2005. On November 24, 2003, LG&E notified the Commission of its intention to seek an adjustment of its gas and electric base rates and tariff terms and conditions.

The consolidation of these two proceedings will facilitate the Commission's review of and decision in these cases. There will be common issues of fact raised in both proceedings, including the allowed rate of return. In addition, the adjustments determined in the rate proceeding may also be at issue in the renewal of LG&E's ESM tariff. The record in Case No. 2003-335 will be complete on January 12, 2004. In the interests of administrative economy, to avoid unnecessary duplication of effort, and to prevent the unnecessary expenditure of resources by the Commission, as well as the parties, the movants submit that the consolidation of the above-captioned proceedings is reasonable. This motion is made without prejudice to the positions taken by the Attorney General and KIUC on the merits of the ESM.

For these reasons, LG&E, the Attorney General, and KIUC request that the Public Service Commission enter an order consolidating Case Nos. 2003-00433 and 2003-00335.
