**MOTION FOR CORRECTION OF APPENDICES
TO JUNE 30, 2004 ORDER**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to enter an order correcting certain information contained in Appendix A to the Commission's Order of June 30, 2004.

As grounds for its motion, LG&E states that on June 30, 2004 the Commission entered an order in this case deciding the issues raised in connection with LG&E's Application for approval of an increase in its electric and gas rates. In Appendix A to that Order, the Commission set forth the approved rates and charges for LG&E's electric and gas service rendered on and after July 1, 2004. Appendix A contains some incorrect or incomplete information. LG&E requests the Commission to enter an Order correcting the rates and charges contained in Appendix A as follows:

LG&E Electric Service Rates

On page 1, under Schedule RPM, the facilities charge should be listed as a \$24.60 annual charge, rather than a \$2.05 monthly charge. Similarly, the customer charge should be listed as a \$60.00 annual charge, rather than a \$5.00 monthly charge. LG&E's Pay As You Go customers may add credits to their prepaid metering cards on an irregular basis. The facilities and customer charges are stated on an annual basis so that a daily prorated amount can be deducted from the

prepaid metering card as the customers use the service, regardless of how often they add credits to their card.

On pages 5 and 6, the Fluctuating Load Charge was omitted from the Schedule LI-TOD rates. The following are the rates and charges for Schedule LI-TOD, which include the Fluctuating Load Charge:

These additions correctly represent the rates and charges as filed by LG&E during the course of this proceeding. LG&E, therefore, requests that the Commission substitute these rates for the rates pertaining to Schedule LI-TOD on pages 5 and 6 of Appendix A to the June 30, 2004 Order.

On page 6, the charges for Rate CSR 3 should be expressed in kVA, rather than kW, since the rider is restricted to customers served under Rate LI-TOD, which contains charges expressed in kVA.

LG&E Gas Service Rates

On page 15, the references to Rate Schedules G-6 and TS should be removed from the listings under Rate AAGS and should instead read:

RATE AAGS
AS AVAILABLE GAS SERVICE


Customer Charge Per Month:	\$ 150.00
Distribution Charge Per Ccf:	\$.05252

Also on page 15, in the rates and charges for Rate FT, the distribution and utilization charges should be expressed as \$.4300 per Mcf, instead of \$.4300 per Ccf. Finally, the Utilization Charge for Daily Imbalances for Rate FT should be \$0.2901. The \$0.3807 figure originally contained on page 15 reflected the Daily Demand Charge which was in effect during the period from November 1, 2003 through January 31, 2004. The current correct Daily Demand Charge in effect for the period from May 1, 2004 through July 31, 2003, pursuant to the Commission's Order of April 29, 2004 in Case No. 2004-00117 is \$0.1701, which results in a total Utilization Charge for Daily Imbalances of \$0.2901.

WHEREFORE, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order revising Appendix A to the Commission's Order of June 30, 2004 as detailed above.

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
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
