OBJECTION TO REQUEST OF MR. ROBERT L. MADISON FOR RECONSIDERATION

Mr. Robert L. Madison ("Mr. Madison") has filed a Request for Reconsideration of the January 21, 2004 Order of Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") denying his Request for Full Intervention into the above-captioned proceeding.

His Request for Reconsideration, dated January 24, 2004, presents no compelling reason for reconsideration of the Commission's January 21, 2004 Order. Mr. Madison has still not demonstrated that he has a special interest in this proceeding which is not otherwise adequately represented by the Attorney General nor has he shown that his intervention would not unduly complicate or disrupt the proceeding. In fact, he is now requesting an extension to the existing procedural schedule.

For the reasons discussed in the Objection of Louisville Gas and Electric Company to Mr. Madison's Request for Full Intervention and recognized in the Commission's January 21, 2004 Order, the Commission should deny Mr. Madison's Request for Reconsideration.
