Seasonal Electric Rate Differential for Residential Customers

In accordance with the Commission's June 30, 2004 Order in the above-referenced case, an informal conference was held on this date to consider and evaluate the impact upon demand of the elimination of Louisville Gas & Electric Company's ("LG&E") seasonal electric rate. This informal conference followed LG&E's December 28, 2006 submission of a report – also required by the June 30, 2004 Order, that concluded there was no unanticipated growth as a result of the change to a single year-round energy rate for residential customers. A list of those attending the informal conference is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Following a review of the purpose of the informal conference as set forth in the Commission's June 30, 2004 Order, LG&E presented a report further detailing the impact that the change in rate structure has had on demand. Questions were asked by the Office of the Attorney General, the Metro Human Needs Alliance and People Organized and Working for Energy Reform as well as Commission Staff.

There being no further items for consideration, the informal conference thereafter adjourned.
