

ORDINANCE NO. 03-1

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HODGENVILLE, KENTUCKY, REVISING
THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND THE SERVICE RENDERED
BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hodgenville, Kentucky (the "City"), is in the process of arranging to finance the construction of certain extensions, additions and improvements to the existing waterworks system (the "System") of the City, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in connection with said plan of financing that the existing monthly water rates be increased, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDIANED BY THE CITY OF HODGENVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Revised Monthly Water Rates. That the rates and charges for water service furnished by the City are hereby revised as follows:

RATES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

- A. Minimum Water Rate. The minimum water bill shall be \$18.34 per month, and each water customer shall be entitled to 3,000 gallons (or less) of water in each month for such minimum charge.
- B. Meter Rates for Water Usage in Addition to Minimum Charge. Subject to the minimum monthly water rate specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons or less of water consumption per month to customers of all size water connections:

| <u>Number of Gallons of Water Per Month</u> | <u>Water Charge Per 1,000 Gallons Per Month</u> |
|---|---|
| First 3,000 gallons | \$18.34 minimum bill |
| Next 7,000 gallons | 4.94 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 10,000 gallons | 4.53 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 20,000 gallons | 3.63 per 1,000 gallons |
| All over 40,000 gallons | 2.45 per 1,000 gallons |

Water sold for resale - \$1.98 per 1,000 gallons

RATES OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS

- A. Minimum water Rate. The minimum water bill shall be \$27.50 per month, and each water customer shall be entitled to 3,000 gallons (or less) of water in each month for such minimum charge.
- B. Minimum Rates for Water Usage in Addition to Minimum Charge. Subject to the minimum monthly water rate specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons or less of water consumption per month to customers of all size water connections:

| <u>Number of Gallons Of Water Per Month</u> | <u>Water Charge Per 1,000 Gallons Per Month</u> |
|---|---|
| First 3,000 gallons | \$27.50 minimum bill |
| Next 7,000 gallons | 7.41 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 10,000 gallons | 6.79 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 20,000 gallons | 5.45 per 1,000 gallons |
| All over 40,000 gallons | 3.68 per 1,000 gallons |



Section 2. Severability. That if any clause, provision, paragraph or section of this Ordinance be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder thereof is intended to be enacted and shall be in full force and effect notwithstanding.

Section 3. All Former Provisions in Conflict Repealed; Effective Date of Ordinance. That all orders, ordinances, motions or parts thereof, insofar as same may be in conflict herewith, are repealed, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.



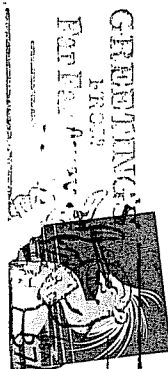
