MOTION OF METRO HUMAN NEEDS ALLIANCE AND PEOPLE ORGANIZED AND WORKING FOR ENERGY REFORM FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Joint Applicants Metro Human Needs Alliance, Inc. ("MHNA") and People Organized and Working for Energy Reform ("POWER") hereby move the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("the Commission") for a Protective Order with respect to the Data Request of Robert Madison dated September 7, 2004.

In an Order dated August 25, 2004, the Commission denied Madison's request for full intervention in this case. The Commission granted limited intervention, which it described as entitling Madison to

the full rights of a party at any hearing in which he appears, and he shall be served with a copy of the Commission's Orders, but he shall not be served with any testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, or any other documents filed by the parties, and he shall not be certified as a party for purposes of receiving service of any petition for rehearing or petition for judicial review.

Order of August 25, 2004 at 3. The language of the Commission's Order is consistent with its administrative regulations, which describe the rights of a party who has been granted limited intervention. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8).

Madison is not entitled to participate in the case beyond the specific terms of the Commission's Order and regulations. Neither the Order nor the regulations authorize

Madison, as a limited intervenor, to issue data requests. On the contrary, the Commission

has provided that Madison as a limited intervenor shall not be served with any documents

filed by the parties. Order of August 25, 2004 at 3; 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8). The

Commission should not allow Madison to circumvent the limitations on his role in the

case by the filing of a data request.

In reaching its decision to deny Madison's request for full intervention, the

Commission noted that Madison lacks the education and professional training to testify as

an expert witness and that he is not likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist

the Commission in fully considering this case without unduly complicating or disrupting

the proceedings. Order of August 25, 2004 at 2. Allowing Madison to submit a lengthy

data request would complicate, disrupt and delay the proceedings, which are on a short

procedural schedule.

For these reasons, MHNA and POWER request that the Commission issue a

protective order specifying that Joint Applicants not be required to respond to Madison's

data request dated September 7, 2004.
