#### APPLICATION

This Application of the McCreary County Water District ("Applicant") of McCreary County, Kentucky, respectfully shows:

1. That Applicant is a water district of McCreary County, Kentucky, created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

2. That the post office address of Applicant is:

McCreary County Water District c/o Mr. Raymond Taylor, Chairman P.O. Box 488 Whitley City, Kentucky 42653

3. That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020 and 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity permitting Applicant to construct a water project, consisting of extensions, additions, and improvements (the "Project") to the existing water system of Applicant; and (ii) an Order approving the proposed plan of financing said Project.

4. That the Project consists of the construction and installation of approximately 18,900 linear feet of 6-inch water line; 170,000 linear feet of 4-inch water line; 117,000 linear feet of 3-inch water line; one hydropneumatic pump station; and one 50,000 gallon elevated water storage tank with appurtenances to serve approximately 225 households.

5. That Applicant proposes to finance the construction of the Project through (i) the issuance of \$750,000 of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds; (ii) a Rural Development ("RD") Grant in the amount of \$950,000; (iii) an Appalachian Regional Commission ("ARC") grant in the amount of \$400,000; (iv) a State of Kentucky Coal Development Fund ("CDF") grant in the amount of

\$920,000; and (v) an Applicant contribution in the amount of \$55,000. Applicant has a commitment from RD to purchase said \$750,000 of bonds maturing over a 40-year period, at an interest rate of not exceeding 4.50% per annum, as set out in the RD Letter of Conditions filed herewith as an Exhibit. The CDF grant was awarded after the issuance of the RD Letter of Conditions, therefore, such grant is not reflected in the financing section of paragraph #22 of such Letter of Conditions.

6. That Applicant does not contemplate having the Project constructed with any deviation from minimum construction standards of this Public Service Commission.

7. That Applicant files herewith the following Exhibits pursuant to 807 KAR 5:069 in support of this Application:

- A. Copy of RD Letter of Conditions.
- B. Copy of RD Letter of Concurrence in Contract Award.
- C. Copy of Preliminary and Final Engineering Reports.
- D. Certified statement from the Chairman of Applicant, based upon statements of the Engineers for Applicant, concerning the following:
  - The proposed plans and specifications for the Project have been designed to meet the minimum construction and operating requirements set out in 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(3) and (4); Section 5(1); Sections 6 and 7; Section 8(1) through (3); Section 9(1) and Section 10;
  - (2) All other state approvals or permits have already been obtained;
  - (3) The existing rates of Applicant shall produce the total revenue requirements set out in the engineering reports; and
  - (4) Setting out the dates when it is anticipated that construction will begin and end.

8. That the foregoing constitutes the documents necessary to obtain the approval of the Kentucky Public Service Commission in accordance with Section 278.023 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and in accordance with the "Minimum Filing Requirements" specified in 807 KAR 5:069, Section 3.

WHEREFORE, Applicant, the McCreary County Water District, asks that the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky grant to Applicant the following:

- a. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity permitting Applicant to construct a water project consisting of extensions, additions, and improvements to the water system of Applicant.
- b. An Order approving the financing arrangements made by Applicant, viz., the issuance of (i) \$750,000 of McCreary County Water District Waterworks Revenue Bonds at an interest rate of not exceeding 4.50% per annum; (ii) a Rural Development grant in the amount of \$950,000; (iii) an ARC grant in the amount of \$400,000; (iv) a CDF grant in the amount of \$920,000; and (v) an Applicant contribution in the amount of \$55,000.

Dear Mr. Taylor:

This letter establishes conditions which must be understood and agreed to by you before further consideration may be given to the application. The loan and/or grant will be administered on behalf of the Rural Utilities Service (RUS) by the State and Area office staff of USDA Rural Development. Any changes in project cost, source of funds, scope of services or any other significant changes in the project or applicant must be reported to and approved by USDA Rural Development, by written amendment to this letter. Any changes not approved by Rural Development shall be cause for discontinuing processing of the application. It should also be understood that Rural Development is under no obligation to provide additional funds to meet an overrun in construction costs.

This letter is not to be considered as loan and/or grant approval or as a representation as to the availability of funds. The docket may be completed on the basis of a RUS loan not to exceed \$750,000, a RUS grant not to exceed \$950,000, and an Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) grant of \$400,000.

If Rural Development makes the loan, the interest rate will be the lower of the rate in effect at the time of loan approval or the rate in effect at the time of loan closing, unless the applicant otherwise chooses. The loan will be considered approved on the date a signed copy of Form RD 1940-1, "Request for Obligation of Funds," is mailed to you.

Please complete and return the attached Form RD 1942-46, "Letter of Intent to Meet Conditions," if you desire that further consideration be given to your application.

The "Letter of Intent to Meet Conditions" must be executed within three weeks from the date of this letter or it becomes invalid unless a time extension is granted by Rural Development.

If the conditions set forth in this letter are not met within 240 days from the date hereof, Rural Development reserves the right to discontinue the processing of the application.

In signing Form RD 1942-46, "Letter of Intent to Meet Conditions," you are agreeing to complete the following as expeditiously as possible:

#### McCreary County Water District

#### 1. Number of Users and Their Contribution:

There shall be 6,014 water users, of which 5,789 are existing users and 225 are new users contributing \$55,000 in connection fees toward the cost of the project. The connection fees will be collected prior to advertising for construction bids and will be placed in the construction account at loan pre-closing, unless spent for authorized purposes prior to loan pre-closing. The Rural Development Manager will review and authenticate the number of users and amount of connection fees prior to advertising for construction bids. No contribution is required from the Water District.

#### 1a. Grant Agreement:

Attached is a copy of RUS Bulletin 1780-12, "Water and Waste System Grant Agreement," for your review. You will be required to execute a completed form at the time of grant closing.

#### 1b. Drug-Free Work Place:

Prior to grant approval, the Water District will be required to execute Form AD-1049, "Certification Regarding Drug-Free Workplace Requirements (Grants) Alternative I - For Grantees Other Than Individuals."

#### 2. Repayment Period:

The loan will be scheduled for repayment over a period not to exceed 40 years from the date of the bond. Principal payment will not be deferred for a period in excess of two years from the date of the bond. Payments will be in accordance with applicable KRS, which requires interest to be paid semi-annually (April 1st and October 1st) and principal will be due on or before the first of April. Rural Development may require the Water District to adopt a supplemental payment agreement providing for monthly payments of principal and interest so long as the bond is held or insured by RUS. Monthly payments will be approximate amortized installments.

# 3. <u>Recommended Repayment Method</u>:

Payments on this loan can be made using the Preauthorized Debit (PAD) payment method. This procedure eliminates the need for paper checks and ensures timely receipt of RD loan payments. To initiate PAD payments, Form SF 5510, "Authorization Agreement for Preauthorized Payments," should be signed by the District to authorize the electronic withdrawal of funds from your designated bank account on the exact installment payment due date. The Rural Development Manager will furnish the necessary forms and further guidance on the PAD procedure.

# 4. <u>Funded Depreciation Reserve Account:</u>

The Water District will be required to deposit \$350.00 per month into a "Funded Depreciation Reserve Account" until the account reaches \$42,000. The deposits are to be resumed any time the account falls below the \$42,000.

The monthly deposits to the Reserve Account are required to commence with the first month of the first full fiscal year after the facility becomes operational.

#### 5. <u>Security Requirements</u>:

A combined pledge of gross water revenue will be provided in the Bond Resolution. Bonds shall rank on a parity with existing bonds, if possible. If this is not possible, the bond will be subordinate and junior to the existing bonds, in which case the Water District will be required to abrogate its right to issue additional bonds ranking on a parity with the existing bonds, so long as any unpaid indebtedness remains on this bond issue.

# 6. Land Rights and Real Property:

The Water District will be required to furnish satisfactory title, easements, etc., necessary to install, maintain and operate the facility to serve the intended users. <u>The pipelines will be on private rights-of-way where feasible</u>. Easements and options are to be secured prior to advertising for construction bids.

#### 7. Organization:

The Water District will be legally organized under applicable KRS which will permit them to perform this service, borrow and repay money.

#### 8. <u>Business Operations</u>:

The Water District will be required to operate the system under a well-established set of resolutions, rules and regulations. A budget must be established annually and adopted by the Water District after review by Rural Development. At no later than loan pre-closing, the Water District will be required to furnish a prior approved management plan to include, as a minimum, provisions for management, maintenance, meter reading, miscellaneous services, billing, collecting, bookkeeping, making and delivering required reports and audits.

# 9. Accounts, Records and Audits:

The Water District will be required to maintain adequate records and accounts and submit annual budgets and year-end reports (annual audits) in accordance with subsection 1780.47 of RUS Instruction 1780 and RUS Staff Instruction 1780-4, a copy of which is enclosed.

# 10. Accomplish Audits for Years in Which Federal Financial Assistance is Received:

The Water District will accomplish audits in accordance with OMB Circular A-133, during the years in which federal funds are received. The Water District will provide copies of the audits to the Area Office and the appropriate Federal cognizant agency as designated by OMB Circular A-133.

#### 11. Insurance and Bonding:

The following insurance and bonding will be required:

- A. Adequate Liability and Property Damage Insurance including vehicular coverage, if applicable, must be obtained and maintained by the Water District. The Water District should obtain amounts of coverage as recommended by its attorney, consulting engineer and/or insurance provider.
- B. Worker's Compensation The Water District will carry worker's compensation insurance for employees in accordance with applicable state laws.
- C. Fidelity Bond The Water District will provide Fidelity Bond Coverage for all persons who have access to funds. Coverage may be provided either for all individual positions or persons, or through "blanket" coverage providing protection for all appropriate employees and/or officials. The amount of coverage required for all RUS loans is \$484,000.
- D. Real Property Insurance The Water District will obtain and maintain adequate fire and extended coverage on all structures including major items of equipment or machinery located in the structures. The amounts of coverage should be based on recommendations obtained by the Water District from its attorney, consulting engineer and/or insurance provider. Subsurface lift stations do not have to be covered except for the value of electrical and pumping equipment therein.
- E. Flood Insurance The Water District will obtain and maintain adequate coverage on any facilities located in a special flood and mudslide prone areas.

# 12. Planning and Performing Development:

- A. The engineer should not be authorized to commence work on final plans and specifications until a determination has been made that the project can be planned and constructed within the estimated cost shown in paragraph "22" of this letter. The engineer may then proceed to develop final plans and specifications to be completed no later than 210 days from this date, and prepare bid documents. The Rural Development Manager is prepared to furnish the necessary guide for him to follow so as to keep the project plans and documents within our guidelines and requirements. The project should not be advertised for construction bids until all easements and enforceable options have been obtained, and total funds are committed or available for the project.
- B. The following documents will be submitted to Rural Development for review and must be concurred in by Rural Development prior to advertisement for construction bids:
  - 1. Final plans, specifications and bid documents.
  - Applicant's letter on efforts to encourage small business and minorityowned business participation.
  - 3. Legal Service Agreements.
  - 4. Engineering Agreements.

Revision in these documents will be subject to Rural Development concurrence. Any agreements, contracts, etc. not reviewed and approved by Rural Development will not be eligible for payment from project funds or revenues from facilities financed by this Agency.

Prior to receipt of an authorization to advertise for construction bids, the Water District will obtain advance clearance from Bond Counsel regarding compliance with KRS 424 pertaining to publishing of the advertisement for construction bids in local newspapers and the period of time the notice is required to be published.

# 13. Compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973:

The Water District will be required to comply with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended (29 U.S.C. 794), in order to make sure no handicapped individual, solely by reason of their handicap, is excluded from participation in the use of the water system, be denied the benefits of the water system, or be subjected to discrimination.

14. Closing Instructions:

The Office of General Counsel, our Regional Attorney, will be required to write closing instructions in connection with this loan. Conditions listed therein must be met by the Water District.

15. Compliance with Special Laws and Regulations:

The Water District will be required to conform with any and all state and local laws and regulations affecting this type project.

#### 16. Treatment Plant/System Operator:

The Water District is reminded that the treatment plant and/or system operator must have an Operator's Certificate issued by the State.

- 17. Prior to Pre-Closing the Loan, the Water District will be Required to Adopt:
  - A. Form RUS Bulletin 1780-27, "Loan Resolution (Public Bodies)."
  - B. Form RD 400-1, "Equal Opportunity Agreement."
  - C. Form RD 400-4, "Assurance Agreement."
  - D. Form AD-1047, "Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Other Responsibility Matters - Primary Covered Transaction."
  - E. Form RD 1910-11, "Applicant Certification Federal Collection Policies for Consumer or Commercial Debts."
  - F. RD Instruction 1940-Q, Exhibit A-1, "Certification for Contracts, Grants and Loans."

The Water District must offer the opportunity for all residents in the service area to become users of the facilities regardless of race, creed, color, religion, sex, national origin, marital status, physical or mental handicap or level of income.

# 18. <u>Refinancing and Graduation Requirements</u>:

The Water District is reminded that if at any time it shall appear to the Government that the Water District is able to refinance the amount of the RUS indebtedness then outstanding, in whole or in part, by obtaining a loan from commercial sources at reasonable rates and terms, upon the request of the Government, the Water District will apply for and accept such loan in sufficient amount to repay the Government.

#### 19. Commercial Interim Financing:

The Water District will be required to use commercial interim financing for the project during construction for the RUS loan portion of the financing, if available at reasonable rates and terms.

Before the loan is closed, the Water District will be required to provide Rural Development with statements from the contractor, engineer and attorneys that they have been paid to date in accordance with their contract or other agreements and, in the case of the contractor, that he has paid his suppliers and sub-contractors.

#### 20. Disbursement of Project Funds:

A construction account for the purpose of disbursement of project funds (RUS) will be established by the Water District prior to start of construction. The position of officials entrusted with the receipt and disbursement of RUS project funds will be covered by a "Fidelity Bond," with USDA Rural Development as Co-Obligee, in the amount of construction funds on hand at any one time during the construction phase.

During construction, the Water District shall disburse project funds in a manner consistent with subsection 1780.76 (e) of RUS Instruction 1780. Form RD 1924-18, "Partial Payment Estimate," or similar form approved by Rural Development, shall be used for the purpose of documenting periodic construction estimates, and shall be submitted to Rural Development for review and acceptance. Prior to disbursement of funds by the Water District, the Board of Directors shall review and approve <u>each</u> payment estimate. <u>All bills and vouchers must be approved by Rural Development prior</u> to payment by the Water District.

Form RD 440-11, "Estimate of Funds Needed for 30-Day Period Commencing \_\_\_\_\_," will be prepared by the Water District and submitted to Rural Development in order that a periodic advance of federal cash may be requested.

Monthly audits of the Water District's construction account records shall be made by Rural Development.

# 21. <u>Disbursement of Grant Funds</u>:

The RUS funds will be advanced as they are needed in the amount(s) necessary to cover the RUS proportionate share of obligations due and payable by the Water District. Grant funds, upon receipt, must be deposited in an interest bearing account in accordance with 7 CFR part 3016 (as applicable). Interest earned on grant funds in excess of \$100 (as applicable) per year will be submitted to RUS at least quarterly.

# 23. Debt Collection Improvement Act (DCIA) of 1996:

The Debt Collection Improvement Act (DCIA) of 1996 requires that <u>all</u> federal payments after January 1, 1999, must be made by Electronic Funds Transfer/Automated Clearing House (EFT/ACH). Borrowers receiving payments by EFT will have funds directly deposited to a specified account at a financial institution with funds being available to the recipient on the date of payment. The borrower should complete Form SF-3881, "Electronic Funds Transfer Payment Enrollment Form," for each account where funds will be electronically received. The completed form(s) must be received by Rural Development at least thirty (30) days prior to the first advance of funds.

# 24. Use of Remaining Project Funds:

The applicant contribution shall be considered as the first funds expended. After providing for all authorized costs, any remaining project funds will be considered to be RUS/ARC grant funds and refunded in proportion to participation in the project. If the amount of unused grant funds exceeds the grants, that part would be RUS loan funds.

#### 25. Rates and Charges:

Rates and charges for facilities and services rendered by the Water District must be at least adequate to meet cost of maintaining, repairing and operating the water system and meeting required principal and interest payments and the required deposits to debt service and/or depreciation reserve.

Water rates will be at least:

Residential & Non-Residential Rates:

#### Prison Rates:

#### 26. <u>Commitment of ARC Grant</u>:

This Letter of Conditions is issued contingent upon a firm commitment being in effect prior to advertising for construction bids for the ARC Grant in the amount of \$400,000.

# 27. Floodplain Construction:

The Water District will be required to pass and adopt a Resolution or amend its By-Laws whereby the Water District will deny any water service to any future customer wishing to build on or develop property located within a designated floodplain. If a customer or developer requests service for construction in a designated floodplain, the customer or developer must provide evidence and a justification for approval by the Water District and Rural Development officials that there are no other alternatives to construction or development within the designated floodplain. The community must be a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and the customer or developer must obtain the required permits prior to the tap on restrictions being waived.

#### 28. Water Withdrawal Permit:

The Water District will be required to obtain satisfactory evidence that a revised water withdrawal permit has been secured from the Division of Water. The permit must be obtained prior to the commencement of construction on the water project.

#### 29. <u>Mitigation Measures</u>:

- A. The Water District shall be required to comply with the requirements of the Kentucky State Clearinghouse as detailed by letter dated June 7, 2002.
- B. The Water District shall be required to comply with the requirements, if any, of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service as requested by letter dated November 22, 2002.
- C. The Water District will comply with all applicable executive orders and regulations that are applicable to the preservation of prime farmlands, wetlands, floodplains, and cultural resources.

#### 30. <u>Final Approval Conditions</u>:

Final approval of this loan will depend on your willingness, with the assistance of all your co-workers, to meet the conditions of this letter in an orderly and systematic manner. Then too, final approval will depend on funds being available.

If you desire to proceed with your application, the Rural Development Manager will allot a reasonable portion of time to provide guidance in application processing.

Dear Mr. Taylor:

On August 24, 2004, bids were received by the McCreary County Water District for the construction of the McCreary County Wide Water System Extensions. The work consisted of Contract 30 and Contract 31 - County Wide Water System Extensions, and Contract 32 - 50,000 Gallon Elevated Water Storage Tank. Four proposals were submitted for Contract 32 and the lowest bid was submitted by Phoenix Fabricators & Erectors, Inc. located in Avon, Indiana for an amount of \$207,082.00. All bids received for Contracts 30 and 31 were rejected by the McCreary County Water District and re-bid on September 13, 2004. Bids received on September 13, 2004 consisted of Contract 30, Contract 31, Contract 33, and Contract 34 - County Wide Water System Extensions. Three proposals were submitted for Contract 30 and the lowest bid was submitted by Stotts Construction Co., Inc. located in Columbia, Kentucky for an amount of \$1,218,746.50. Four proposals were submitted for Contract 31 and the lowest bid was submitted by Stotts Construction Co., Inc. located in Columbia, Kentucky for an amount of \$868,438.00. Three proposals were submitted for Contract 33 and the lowest bid was submitted by Stotts Construction Co., Inc. located in Columbia, Kentucky for an amount of \$496,916.50. Three proposals were submitted for Contract 34 and the lowest bid was submitted by Stotts Construction Co., Inc. located in Columbia, Kentucky for an amount of \$409,933.50. The sum of Contracts 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 is \$3,201,116.50. A copy of the summarized bid tabulation of all bids received is attached along with a Project Budget.

The amount of construction funds budgeted is \$2,294,266.50, thus there are insufficient funds to award all five contracts. Therefore, we recommend that the McCreary County Water District consider awarding Contract 30 to Stotts Construction Co., Inc. for an amount of \$1,218,746.50, Contract 31 to Stotts Construction Co., Inc. for an amount of \$868,438.00, and Contract 32 to Phoenix Fabricators & Erectors, Inc. for an amount of \$207,082.00 with the intent to seek other sources for funding of Contracts 33 and 34. This recommendation is contingent upon approval by the U.S.D.A Rural Development and the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
