

By Order entered January 20, 2005 in this matter, Jackson Energy Cooperative ("Jackson Energy") was directed to submit to the Commission within twenty (20) days a written Response to the allegations contained in the Incident Investigation Report dated October 14, 2004 as attached to the January 20, 2005 Commission Order.

For its written Response, Jackson Energy hereby states that the allegations contained in the Incident Investigation Report of October 14, 2004 do appear to be accurate and correct as to the incident description and other basic identifying information as summarized in the report.

With respect to the probable violation and recommendations noted in the October 14, 2004 Incident Investigation Report, Jackson Energy is prepared to discuss same with Commission staff and hereby requests in writing an informal conference for the purpose of doing so, and would further note that telephone discussions have already taken place between the undersigned and employees of the Commission's legal staff, scheduling such a conference on Thursday, February 10, 2005 at

1:30 p.m. at the Commission offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. At that time, Jackson Energy is prepared to have present its President and CEO, Don Schaefer; its present Vice-President of Engineering and Operations, Ron Fuller; its Safety Director, Gary Farmer; and its Operations Superintendent, Harold Hays.
