**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AN AMENDED APPLICATION**


Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(5), Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to file an Amended Application. In support of its Motion, LG&E states as follows:

On December 1, 2004, LG&E filed an Application with the Commission for approval of a new rate tariff containing a mechanism for the pass-through of MISO-related revenues and costs not already included in existing base rates for LG&E. Following the filing of the Application, an informal conference was held on December 17, 2004. LG&E now seeks to amend its Application to provide additional support to demonstrate the Commission's authority to approve this new tariff. Commonwealth of Kentucky, ex. rel. Gregory Stumbo, Attorney General and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, each an Intervenor in this case, have indicated that they have no objection to this motion.

**WHEREFORE**, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully requests the Commission to enter an order granting it leave to amend its application.


