INTERSTATE GAS SUPPLY, INC.'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

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Now comes Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. ("IGS"), by counsel, and moves for full intervenor status in this action pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), to the fullest extent permitted by law, on behalf of itself and the significant number of consumers it serves pursuant to the current small volume transportation program ("Choice Program"). IGS's basis for intervention is that Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc.'s ("Columbia") November 30, 2004 application will directly impact IGS, its current Choice Program customers, and potential customers who would have the opportunity for service under the proposed Choice Program.

IGS, the largest competitive supplier in the Choice Program, has been granted full intervenor status in the Columbia's current transportation program case, Case No. 1999-00165. Indeed, as the Commission is aware, IGS has been substantially involved in discussions with Columbia to propose this new pilot program to replace the ongoing pilot program, as well as a permanent Choice Program.

IGS respectfully requests the Commission to expeditiously approve the new proposed Choice Program. Due to the uncertainty associated with the pending termination of the current

Choice Program, IGS has been unable to make additional offers to its current and new customers beyond March 2005. IGS believes that the Commission should install a permanent Choice Program, and that interim approval of this proposed pilot program is appropriate to allow more Kentucky consumers to take advantage of the benefits and opportunities of competitively purchasing their natural gas commodity needs.

WHEREFORE, IGS respectfully requests intervention in the above-captioned matter.
