

PETITION TO INTERVENE

Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, by counsel, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8), petitions for full intervention in the above captioned proceeding and in support thereof states as follows:

1. The Applicant, Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, is a municipal corporation organized pursuant to KRS 67(C). The population within the boundaries of the Applicant is approximately 693,000 substantially all of which represent residential and business customers of Louisville Gas & Electric Company ("LG&E"). The purpose of Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government intervening in this proceeding is to participate in the determination of the need and basis for and the cost of constructing a second generating unit at the Trimble County Station and the impact it will have on its citizens and business customers.

2. The issues in this docket may have a significant impact on the rates Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government and its citizens pay to LG&E for electric service.


3. Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government and the residential and business customers residing therein cannot be adequately represented by any existing party. The Applicant intends to play a constructive role in this proceeding and its participation will not complicate, delay or disrupt the proceeding. The Applicant is aware of the procedural schedule adopted by the Commission and states that it does not intend to submit initial data requests to LG&E.

4. The Jefferson County Attorney is the legal advisor to Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government and is authorized to represent it in this proceeding. Service of all documents, orders and other filings shall be made on the Jefferson County Attorney at the following address:


