ORDER

On August 22, 2005, Commission Staff issued to Southeastern Water Association ("Southeastern Water") a data request which contained the following items:

- 1. Provide Complainant's billing records from December 2003 until present.
- 2. Did Southeastern Water conduct an investigation of Complainant's claim regarding his billing? If yes, provide the documents and details resulting from the investigation.
- 3. Did Southeastern Water test Complainant's meter after his complaint? If yes, provide the results of the test.
 - 4. Provide the testing history for Complainant's meter.

Southeastern Water was requested to provide responses to the above items within 10 days of the date of the data request. Southeastern Water has not responded to the data request.

On May 1, 2006, Commission Staff reissued the previous data request to Southeastern Water, requesting responses to be filed by May 11, 2006. Southeastern Water filed partial responses on May 11, 2006.

Southeastern Water's responses do not address Items 3 and 4 of the data request. Because the information requested in these items are important to the resolution of this case, Southeastern Water must file these responses. Failure to respond timely could result in a finding for Complainant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Southeastern Water shall file with the Commission its responses to Items 3 and 4 of the August 22, 2005 Commission Staff data request.
- 2. Extensions of time in which to respond to this Order shall be granted only for good cause.
