Because this matter is pending before the Kentucky Public Service Commission, I cannot discuss it in any substantive way. Your e-mail will be made a part of the record.

I can assure you that the Commission takes this matter seriously. That is why, at a meeting on February 14, members of the PSC staff met with representatives of Atmos Energy and the Attorney General to determine how to move this matter forward. A procedural schedule was established and was the subject of a Commission order issued on March 6. I have attached a copy of the order, which includes the procedural schedule reflecting the wishes of the Attorney General and Atmos.

A public hearing in the case will be held early next year. I realize that this will be a lengthy proceeding, but the issues involved are difficult and complex.
