Please be advised that I am writing this letter on behalf of my client, Bluegrass Farms and Woodlands, LLC, as an adjoining property owner in Garrard County, Kentucky, in reference to the proposed site that Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless, desires to place a cell tower.

My client objects to the placing of the cell town because it will decrease the value of the surrounding real estate and will diminish the aesthetic appeal of the area which is predominantly agricultural and residential.

Furthermore, with this letter we are submitting a copy of the letter that we have sent to Cellco requesting the following information: the need for the placement of this tower at this site, a list of all other sites considered for placement in Garrard County, the reason(s) such other sites were rejected, the total of the number of towers owned or accessed by Verizon in Garrard County, the location of the nearest tower to this site presently being accessed by Verizon, the preferred distance of each tower from each other, the saturation point for towers in a given geographic area, the revenue anticipated to be generated by the presence of the proposed tower, and the projected range of the transmissions for this tower.

We understand that such towers are normally approved by the Public Service Commission unless we can demonstrate that another location is available and more suitable for the placement. Therefore, we are requesting this information herein sought in order to assist the Commission in determining the necessity of the placement of the proposed unsightly tower, especially considered the anticipated reduction in the value of the property that my client owns to be located near such proposed tower.

With letter we are requesting that the Commission not proceed any further in reference to docket number 2005-00059, until such time that the information requested from Cellco has been provided to us.

We are also requesting with this letter all of our rights as an adjoining property owner to object to the placement of the tower in question, and procedures for participation in the matter on the docket hereinabove referenced.

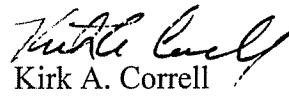

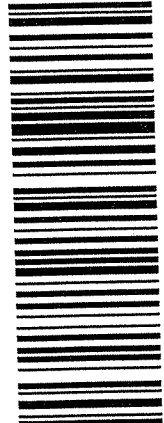
