**APPLICANT’S RENEWED MOTION TO SUBMIT  
FOR EXPEDITED DECISION WITHOUT PUBLIC HEARING**

Cellco Partnership, a Delaware General Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Applicant”), by counsel, renews its Motion to Submit for Expedited Decision Without Public Hearing and requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“PSC”) grant a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) forthwith in this case, based on the following facts and circumstances:

1. On March 14, 2005, Applicant moved the PSC to submit the subject case for expedited decision without public hearing.
2. The PSC granted Intervention in the subject case to Bluegrass Farms and Woodlands, LLC shortly after Applicant filed its Motion, and the PSC has not ruled upon Applicant’s Motion during the pendency of said Intervention.
3. Bluegrass Farms and Woodlands, LLC, as the sole Intervenor in the within case, has withdrawn its protest against the subject site, as noticed by a Notice to

Withdraw Protest filed with the PSC on June 13, 2005. A copy of said Notice is attached as **Exhibit A** to this Renewed Motion.

5. The Application that is the subject of this administrative proceeding was originally filed with the PSC on February 8, 2005, and has been pending before the PSC for 126 days as of the date of this Renewed Motion.

6. The wireless communications facility that is the subject of the Application for a CPCN filed in this case remains a vital element of the Applicant's wireless communications network, and is necessary to provide service in accordance with the provisions of Applicant's Federal Communications Commission license.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant, by counsel, urges the PSC to grant a CPCN forthwith in accordance with the terms of the Application in this proceeding and without public hearing.


